

Desert Rivers Audubon COVID-19 Policy

Desert Rivers Audubon will adhere to all to all recommendations of the Centers for Disease Control and the Arizona Department of Public Health. We plan to present our full schedule of activities, however some may move online.

The following ground rules will be enforced at all activities until further notice:

- Temperatures will be taken at every event.
- Masks will be required, and social distancing enforced.
- A mask will be provided if the guest does not have one.
- A participant who does not wear a mask will be asked to leave.
- Gloves will be provided for volunteers handling books or money.
- Hand sanitizer that is at least 60% alcohol will be available at all events.
- Sanitizing wipes will be used on items that are touched.

Speaker Programs

Monthly talks will continue September through April.

The September, October and November programs will be online only.

The decision to present subsequent programs in person or online will be made one month prior to the event, based on public health conditions. Members will be notified.

Birdwalks

As birdwalks are outside, they will continue on the regular schedule.

Masks will be required and social distancing enforced.

Every effort will be made to limit groups to family members.

Groups will be limited to 10 people.

Participants are strongly encouraged to bring their own binoculars.

Binoculars will be loaned only once per outing.

Owl Walks

Owl walks will continue the fourth Saturday of the month.

Masks will be required and social distancing enforced.

Binoculars will not be loaned.

Hummingbird Habitat

Garden maintenance work at the Hummingbird Habitat will continue.

Masks will be required and social distancing enforced.

Field Trips

Field trip leaders will make final decisions on issues that might arise on the trip.

Field Trips will be limited to 10 people.

Temperatures will be taken.

Masks will be required and social distancing enforced.

Car-pooling is optional at the risk of the participants.

Participants are encouraged to bring hand-sanitizer.
